- 1 ORGANIZE**

 - **Assemble** leadership team with a diverse group of stakeholders
 - **Schedule** training sessions with NAPE
 - **Collect** disaggregated data on student participation, performance, and completion at the national, state, and school levels
- 2 EXPLORE**

 - **Analyze** the data and explore differences
 - **Identify** participation and completion gaps
 - **Examine** the gaps for specific demographic groups: gender, race, socioeconomic status, disability, and English-language learner
- 3 DISCOVER**

 - **Review** research on Root Causes
 - **Develop** a hypothesis
 - **Test** hypotheses with action research
 - **Validate** the Root Causes of the gaps

A **Root Cause** is a barrier to student participation and completion within one of five frameworks: Education, Career Information, Family, Internal, Societal.
- 4 SELECT**

 - **Research** strategies and interventions proven to address the Root Causes
 - **Select** the most feasible, high-impact strategy given local resources
- 5 ACT**

 - **Create** an evaluation plan and metrics
 - **Implement** the strategy or intervention
 - **Measure** the results
- 6 REFLECT**

 - **Reflect** on the results
 - **Present** the results
- 7 REPEAT**

 - **Repeat** the PIPE process to broaden the impact
